## VETERAN'S APPLICATION FOR NAME INSCRIPTION

The Town of Cornelius and American Legion Post 86 jointly approved the construction of a Veterans Monument on a lot adjacent to Main Street in Cornelius behind Town Hall which would honor all Cornelius veterans, living or deceased, who had actively served in the U.S. Armed Services, received an honorable discharge and lived in Cornelius at some point in their lives.

The veterans' names would be inscribed on the walls of the monument in phases. Deadline for the first phase entry of names was July 31, 2011. During that period 1,115 names of Cornelius veterans were collected. Those names will be inscribed on the walls of the monument for all to see and honor on the Opening Day ceremony of the monument on Veterans Day, November 11, 2011.

The second phase of name inscriptions is now being collected with this application. Those names will be placed on the wall at some future date to be determined by the Cornelius Veterans Monument Committee.
